Loving God ♥ Loving You

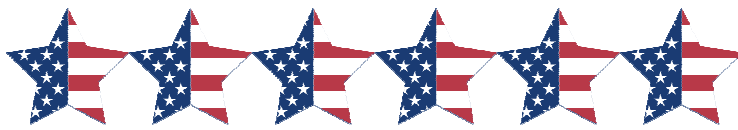
